It seems like we never have enough time to get everything done nor do we ever have enough personal time just for ourselves. It is a disease that effects us all—”competition”. Competition within ourselves, toward others, in life, family, church, on the job. It is a cycle that never ends. The root of our problem is SELF IMAGE. We are so concerned with what others think that we become consumed with the idea that everything and everyone has to be perfect or we can not be happy and fulfilled. So what can we do?

- 6 things you can do right now to make a difference
1. Be more mature but not less playful.
 2. Choose to be happy no matter what
 3. Don’t expect so much from others
 4. Finish what you start before taking on something else.

One lady excepted this advice and here is what she said “Okay, I am great at starting things and TERRIBLE at finishing. Today I sat down and finished the things I need to get done at work. Even though I ended up working two and a half hours past 5 o’clock, I was really proud of myself. I plan to make a short “to do lists” of things I want to get done for the day and check them off as I go. I think the best time for me make my list is in the evening that way I can plan my day out the night before. We’ll see how that works out!

5. Take time to sit at a park or some private place and learn to become at peace with your thoughts and environment. Bible calls it mediation and tells us to “be still”. Ps 4:2, 46:10, 84:4 Mark 4:39

6. Don’t procrastinate—Set a time to start. How about start right now!

Sub Topic: Spiritual indicators

Memory Verse: 2 Peter 3:14

Scripture: 2 Peter 3:14-18

Introduction: We can expect to experience the following spiritual indicators as we mature in the Holy Spirit. Place this section in your Bible. A great way to progress in your Christian life.

I. A Growing hunger to know God.

If your growing you will have an always growing desire to know Him more and know more about Him.

II. A Desire to know the truth of the Word.

If your growing your understanding of God's Word becomes more personal to you in your life.

III. An increasing awareness of our sinfulness.

If your growing you become more aware of your sinfulness and your righteousness with God. Not to feel worthless but your spirit will mature and simply not tolerate the same sins we once so easily committed. We become more aware.

IV. A quick repentant response to sin.

When we stumble we know that we repent and ask the Holy Spirit to help us to mature in that area of our lives.

V. A growing reliance on the Holy Spirit.

We will learn to trust the Holy Spirit as we learn to completely rely on God's. Sometimes our best growth comes during out painful times.
