Serve by witnessing for Christ

Acts 4:29-33; 8:4 Prov. 11:30 Mark 16:15
The early Christians, because of their excitement, quickly spread the Gospel to all parts of the Roman Empire. The key to this witnessing zeal is found in Acts 1:8. We need that same zeal of witnessing to serve our Lord.

I. Hindrances of witnessing for Christ

- What hindrance do we find mentioned in Jn 7:13 and Jn 12:42-43?
- What happens if we look to use our life for our own desires and wishes? Mark 8:35,38)
- Do we have Christ's command to be a witness for Him? Matthew 28:19-20.

II. Helps for witnessing for Christ.

- Whose assured presence do we have. Matthew 28:19-20
- Whose assured power do we have? Acts 1:8, Luke 24:49)
- Whose assured peace do we have? Luke 24:36
- Whose assured plan do we have? Luke 24:45-48

III. Heroes of witnessing for Christ.

- How badly did Paul desire others to be saved? Romans 9:3, 10:1
- Was Peter burdened over the souls of others? Acts 2:37, 41.
- What was Christ's mission to this world? Luke 19:10

Has God laid someone on your heart to witness too? Have you ever gone to a funeral and said, "Oh, I wish I had taken the time to tell them about Jesus the Christ!" Someone once said, when is the best time to talk to someone about Jesus - answer: while they are still alive. The Bible says

2 Cor 6:2 For he saith, I have heard thee in a time accepted, and in the day of salvation have I succoured thee: behold, now is the accepted time; behold, now is the day of salvation.)

Friday Youth Activities

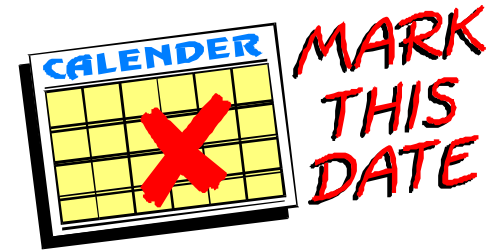
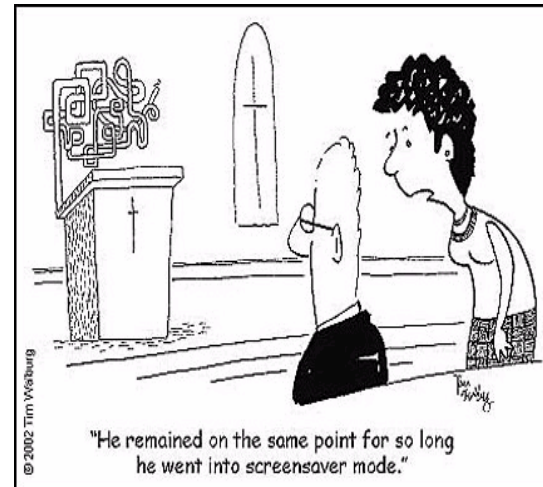
