When Daniel described God's wisdom, he wrote,

(Dan 2:21 KJV) And he changeth the times and the seasons: he removeth kings, and setteth up kings: he giveth wisdom unto the wise, and knowledge to them that know understanding: **(22)** He revealeth the deep and secret things: he knoweth what is in the darkness, and the light dwelleth with him.

Nothing's ever a mystery to God. He is never puzzled or confused or uncertain. Paul tries to talk about the wisdom of God, and when he does, it moves to praise: "Oh, the depth of the riches both of the wisdom and the knowledge of God! How unsearchable His judgments and untraceable His ways! For who has known the mind of the Lord? Or who has been His counselor? Or who has ever first given to Him, and has to be repaid? For from Him and through Him and to Him are all things. To Him be the glory forever. Amen."

(Rom. 11:33-36)

What the apostle is saying is that God's wisdom is very deep--so deep that His judgments are unsearchable. I can't get there from here; it's beyond me. God's wisdom is so deep that His ways are untraceable. I can't follow what He's doing without being hopelessly over my head. It is so deep that no one has been or could be His counselor, ever. In fact, the wisdom of God is so deep and so expansive that He does not and cannot increase in wisdom. The only way He could increase in wisdom is for something to come into God's mind that has not already come out of God's mind. But **Romans 11:36** insists that this cannot be done: for from Him and through Him and to Him are all things.

So God's actions are always perfectly wise. Romans 8:28

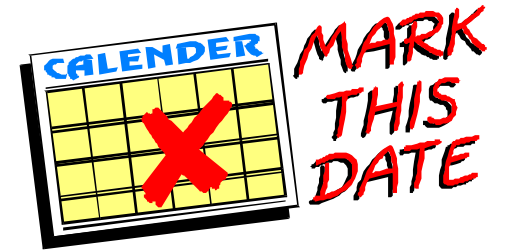
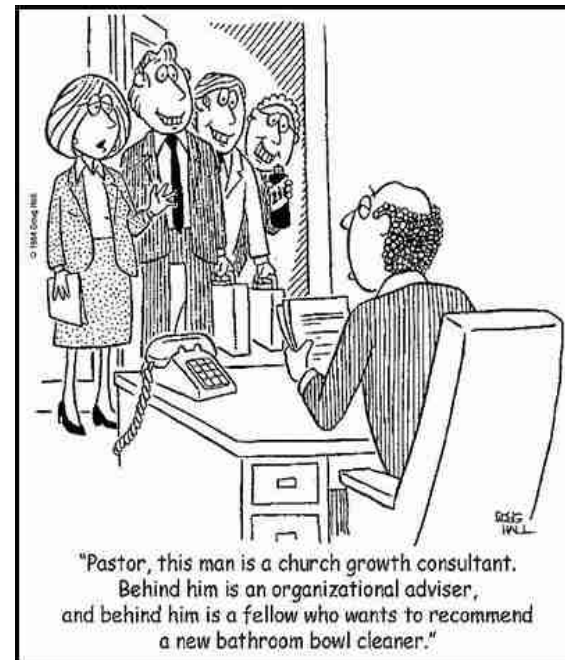
