SELF-CONTROL: The moon slipped behind the clouds leaving behind the night's darkness. Two figures, hidden by the night shadows, crept silently towards Saul's camp. Just beyond the camp fire's light David and Abishai stopped, spotting Saul and his guards sleeping. "Le me smite him," Abishai softly murmured. What a most natural thing to say. Here, at their disposal, was a man who was actively seeking the murder David. But for the second time David demonstrated self-control in not killing Saul. No one could blame him or accuse his actions and desires, thus assuring spiritual success. Self-control is one of the most important traits in the Christian life. More than anything else it will help you live a life that is pleasing to God. Consider the lack of self-control is one of the main reasons for broken relationships, hurt feelings and spiritual defeat. 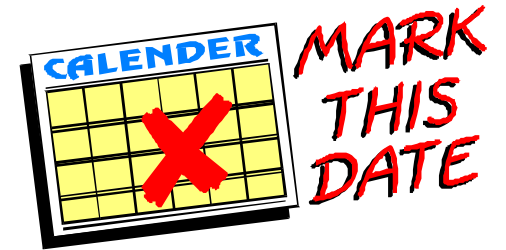
