Topic: Be Loyal

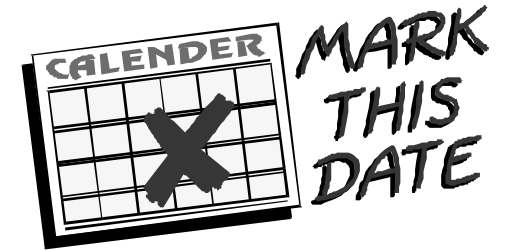
