12% of salesmen keep on calling.

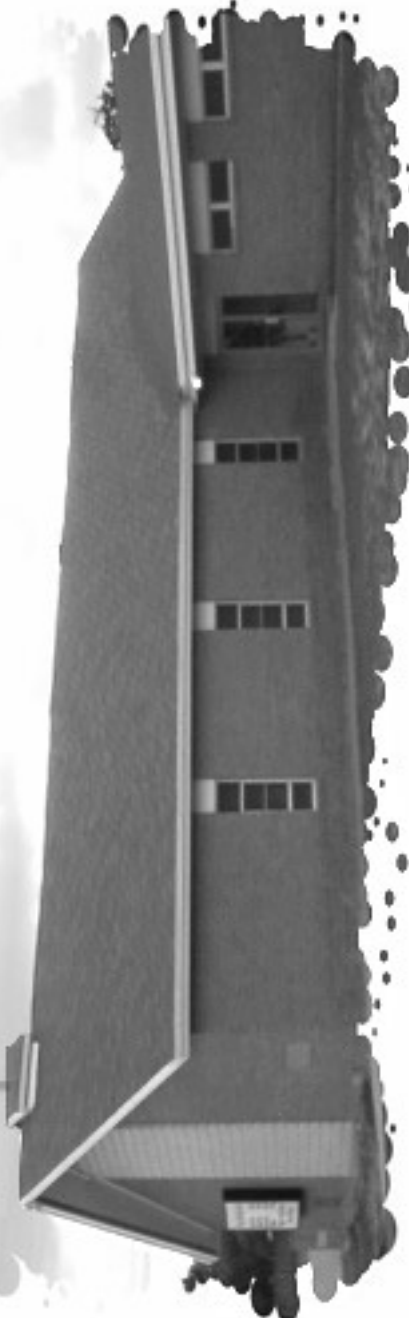

Topic: Serve by witnessing for Christ

INTRODUCTION: The early Christians, because of their excitement, quickly spread the Gospel to all parts of the Roman Empire. The key to this witnessing zeal is found in **Acts 1:8**. Once again, we need that same zeal of witnessing to serve our Lord.

II. HELPS FOR CRITICISM

- What should our attitude be when persecution comes? **(Matthew 5:15)**
- Will we ever be separated from Christ's love? **(Romans 8:35-39)**
- What great advice does the LORD give us in **I Peter 4:16-19**? How should we treat those who are criticizing and persecuting us? **(Romans 12;14,17-23)**

III. THE HEROS WHO SURVIVED UNDER THE HAND OF CRITICISM.

- Was Paul victorious? **(II Timothy 4:6-8)**
 - What were the apostles' reaction to their sufferings? **(Acts 5:40,41)**
 - What did Paul and Silas do while they were in jail? **(Acts 16:20-25)**
- (Acts 20:19 KJV)** Serving the Lord with all humility of mind, and with many tears, and temptations, which befell me by the lying in wait of the Jews: **(Acts 20:20 KJV)** And how I kept back nothing that was profitable unto you, but have showed you, and have taught you publicly, and from house to house,

The late John Candy appears as a former American Gold Medalist who is now coaching the Jamaican team. As the story develops, we learn that Candy's character has a dark secret in his athletic past: After his gold medal performance, he broke the rules by weighting the U.S. Sled. One of the Jamaicans on the team questions why anyone who has already won a medal would feel compelled to cheat. "I had to win" says the coach. "But I learned something". If you're not happy without gold medal, you won't be happy with it.
