One of the hardest things for people to do is to stand alone while others ridicule and mock. It is this fear of rejections that causes many to fall spiritually. Yet, to stand alone if need be, is exactly what God expect of us no matter what the circumstance are. It's not often easy, no pleasant, but it is God glorifying.

In I Kings 22:13; 14:23-28 Micaiah stood alone when the 400 lying prophets of king Ahab told the king to go into battle, it was only Micaiah who told the truth. The price he paid was physical abuse, rejection, and finally imprisonment. But he still did right for the Lord.

Jesus stood alone Mat. 26:56 on the night of His betrayal. When it came right down to living for Christ we see that the disciples were just NOT ready. But Jesus still did what He was called to do -- to pray for our sins, to die for our sins, to shed His blood for our sins, to forgive us of our sins, to save us from our sins. He stood alone so that you and I could have a chance to be reunited with God the Father through His shed blood and His resurrection. Romans 10:9-13 "...For whosever shall CALL UPON THE NAME OF THE LORD SHALL BE SAVED!"

Topic: Following God's Plan

PRAYER THOUGHT: Do you follow God's plan for your life? Consider letting God have complete control of your life today!

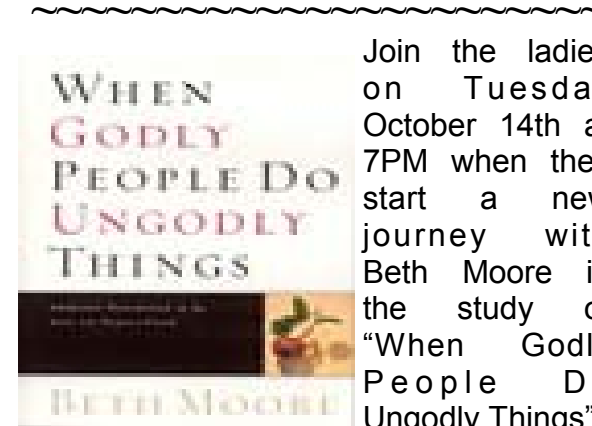
FROM THE YOUTH DEPARTMENT:

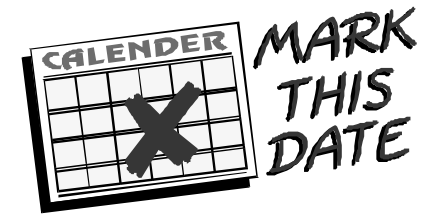


Join the ladies on Tuesday October 14th at 7PM when they start a new journey with Beth Moore in the study of "When Godly People Do Ungodly Things".
