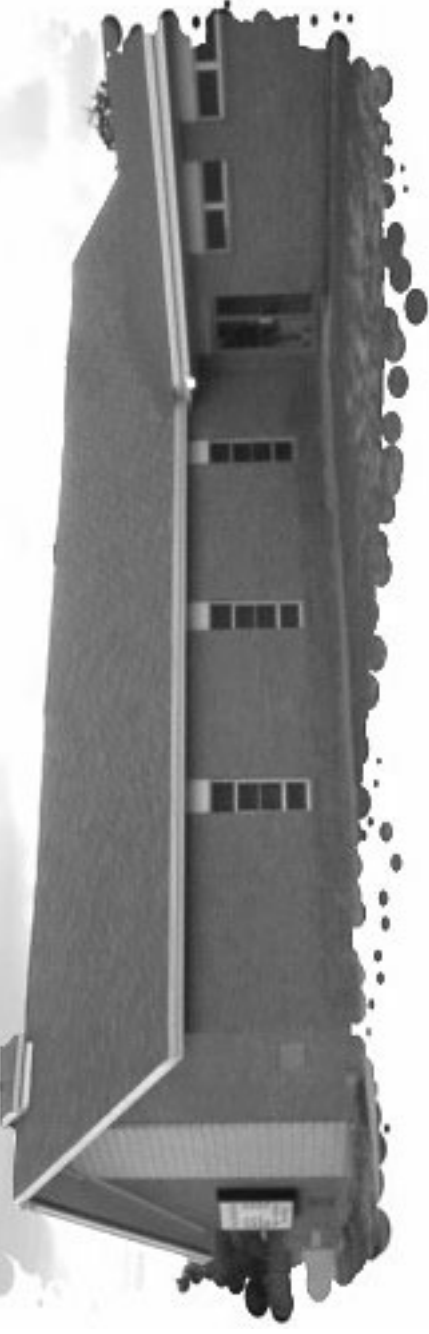

Topic: Our duty to have a servants heart!

PRAYER THOUGHT:

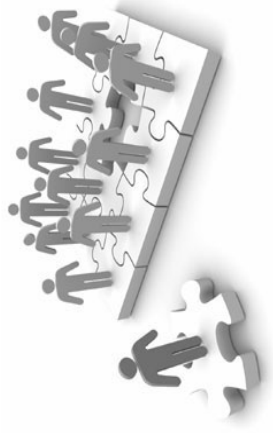
Make a list of all the things Christ did that demonstrated the faithfulness of His service for the Father in Heaven.
